KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



David Nasser

David Nasser was raised in Iran as a sophisticated, educated Muslim. A privileged child, David had visited every continent by the time he was a nine-year old. During the Iranian Revolution of 1979, moderate Muslims throughout that nation became persecuted. David's father, fearing for his family's safety, fled the country, leaving behind everything they possessed. Young David lived a year in exile before entering life as a foreigner in a vastly different culture – the American South. For this terrified teen, the potentially destructive power of religion and the trauma of prejudice inspired a compelling search for value and meaning, culminating in his discovery that peace and self-worth are only found in a personal relationship with the Messiah. His first book, *A Call To Die*, is a best-seller that focuses on being honest with God, denying our desires, serving the Creator, and finding a life rich in Godly rewards, rather than earthly ones. Today, David Nasser addresses some 500,000 people each year, presenting a call to faith and to take action on behalf of our world's most forgotten people.



Rick Donlon, MD

Rick Donlon, MD grew up in New Orleans and completed medical school at LSU-N.O., and a combined Internal Medicine and Pediatrics residency at the University of Tennessee, Memphis. In 1995 he and three medical school classmates opened Christ Community Health Services, a primary-care health center for the poor in Memphis' most medically underserved neighborhood. Christ Community eventually grew to include eight health centers, three dental clinics, and a family medicine residency program, providing over 160,000 patient visits in 2013.

In 2014, Dr. Donlon and twenty other physicians and mid-level providers founded Resurrection Health, continuing their original vision of community-based, Christ-centered primary and hospital care for the least served—in Memphis and around the world. Dr. Donlon, his wife Laurie, and their seven children live in the Binghampton neighborhood.

Gary Morsch


2015 Comninellis Award for Compassionate Service to Humanity

Since 2012, Dr. Loper is again at the helm of Good Shepherd Clinic, providing medical and dental care through an exceptional practice that provides prevention, wellness and sick care to low-income, uninsured people throughout central Oklahoma.


Meredith Jackson

2015 INMED International Medicine Award Recipient


